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Welcome to the Ministry of Gender, Labour & Social Development (MGLSD) Management Information System for Orphans and other Vulnerable children (OVC MIS). The main objective of the OVC MIS is to measure progress towards achieving the goal of the National Strategic Program Plan of OVC Interventions (NSPPI). The OVC National Implementation Unit (OVCNIU) in the Ministry coordinates the national effort for OVC. Over 4,000 non-government, civil society, faith-based and community organizations support this national effort by providing care and support for OVC. The OVC MIS is a central hub for OVC related data in Uganda.

National OVC Cross cutting Situation Indicators for the year 2012

1. Total Population of children in Uganda also reflected as a per cent of the total Ugandan population -19,566,430 children based on UBOS population Projections for 2012. Generally the percentage of children to the population is 56%.
2. 52% of the population is under 15 years of age
3. Less than one percent of children under age 5 tested positive for HIV (AIDS Indicator Survey 2011).
4. Percentage of children under age 18 who are orphans (11.5% UDHS 2011)
5. Percentage of children under age 18 who are vulnerable(38% UNHS 2009/10)
6. 19% of the children not living with biological parent (UDHS ,2011)
7. Number of children who live without an adult care-giver 32,000.
8. **Percentage of Children living below the poverty line**

2. Creating a CSO Account

3. A data entry interface similar to the one below will be displayed. Take note of the following when creating CSO accounts, namely;
 - a. The Selected role must be **Service Provider**.
 - b. Ensure the district is selected.
 - c. Ensure the organization field is selected as this will be the only organization the account to be created will report for only.
 - d. If the organization field is not selected, the system will assume a district account is being created.
